Sports Without Borders Foundation

Important Financial Information

In October 2005, Swinburne University and the promoters of Sports Without Borders (then being The Hellenic Australian Sports Foundation Incorporated and James Demetriou) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding in respect of the establishment of a non-profit community foundation known as Sports Without Borders. The Foundation was subsequently enacted under Statute 24 - Foundations Statute 2004 of the Swinburne University of Technology Act 1992 (Vic).

All money held, received or raised for the Foundation and all accumulations from the investment of such monies must be held by the University and recorded in a separate University ledger account in the name of the Foundation and (subject to any necessary deduction for administration and outgoings of a like nature) must only be expended in accordance with the Objects of the Foundation and on the recommendation of the Board in consultation with the University. No monies of the Foundation may be applied to any other objects or purposes whatsoever.

Objects of Foundation

The Objects of the Foundation are to:

- (1) develop, through the activities of the Foundation and its association and development work undertaken with other organisations, an understanding of particular barriers to participation in sport experienced by refugee youth in Australian society;
- (2) develop and implement innovative platforms and initiatives to help overcome those barriers by highlighting the messages and opportunities arising through sport;
- (3) develop linkages, associations and agreements with public, private and community organisations and funding bodies to increase support for these Objects;
- (4) raise community awareness of issues relevant to the activities of the Foundation;
- (5) pursue associated educational and research activities and opportunities;
- (6) provide support for and opportunities to students and academics studying and working in fields conducive to the attainment of these Objects;
- (7) create, publish and disseminate information in connection with these Objects;
- (8) solicit donations, gifts and bequests to the Foundation for the purpose of achieving the Objects;
- (9) support other such things or activities at the University which are necessary, incidental or conducive to the advancement of these Objects.

When donating to the Foundation, donors are required to indicate that their donation is to be used for scholarships. This ensures that 100% of your donation goes to the young people who need your help.
